





4. Part Names and Functions



1. Mode switch (TF / OFF / \rightarrow)
2. LED torch
3. Speakers
4. Indicator LED
5. Function switch (V+K / M / M.V.)
6. Charging socket
7. Headphone socket
8. TF card reader

5. MP3 Player

This device plays music from a TF memory card.

- 1) Insert a TF card into the reader, slide the Mode switch to TF and your music will automatically start to play. During playback the indicator LED flashes.
- 2) Whilst music is playing, sliding the Function switch briefly towards V+K will bring you back to the previous track, holding it towards V+K will increase the volume, sliding it briefly towards M.V. will skip you to the next track and holding it towards M.V. will reduce the volume. Pressing down on the Function switch will pause and pressing again will resume playback.

- 3) Please note that the speakers are automatically muted when using the device with headphones.

6. LED Torch

This device has a built-in LED torch, turn the switch to \rightarrow , the torch will turn on, turn the switch to OFF, the torch will turn off.

7. Power Supply

This device has a built-in Lithium rechargeable battery which can be charged using a computer's USB port through the supplied USB cable or using mains power with a mains to USB adaptor (not included).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	USB cable loose/ faulty or Lithium battery flat	Check USB cable
Music stored on memory card but MP3 player not playing	Music file(s) format not compatible or memory card faulty	Convert music file(s) to correct format or try different memory card
Battery does not charge or reduced life	The internal battery is too old and needs to be changed	Get battery changed by an authorised service centre
